On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Flemish Boxing League, it is our pleasure to welcome you to the Brussels Round Robin Boxing Series.

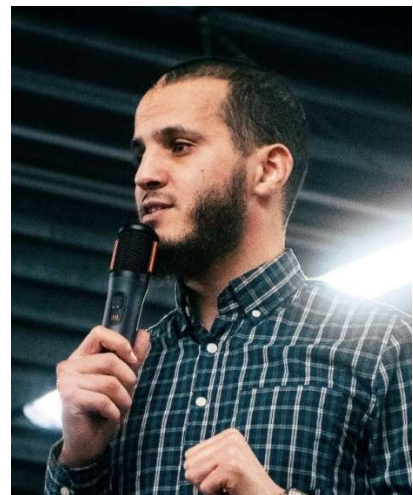

4. ENTRY PROCESS

It is required that respective participating teams confirm the technical and medical standard of the boxers and other team members. Participating teams are also responsible for submitting the personal data on behalf of each member of their team, and for ensuring that the personal information provided during the entry process is accurate. At this time, the entry process for teams is completed via email, as specified in the table below:

Entering reserve boxers is strongly encouraged to allow for substitutions after the entry deadline prior to the Boxing Entries Check. It is strongly advised for all participating teams with three or more participating boxers to delegate the highest standard of national certified Referee and Judge as a part of their Teams. Each participating team can enter the following number of Team Members in the official Delegation to accompany the boxers:

# of boxers	# of accompanying Team Members
1-2	2 coaches + R&J + team manager + support staff
3-7	3 coaches + 2 R&J + team manager + support staff
8+	5 coaches + 2 R&J + team manager + support staff

The number of coaches eligible for free accreditation will depend on the number of participating boxers. Any additional coaches will require a paid accreditation. It is the responsibility of participating teams to ensure that all Team Members are qualified to perform their duties.

R&J's must provide a proof of eligibility by their national federation prior to arrival.

4.1 Boxing Entries Check

The Boxing Entries check is the final part of the event entry process. The LOC will inform Teams of their exact appointment time prior to the event as well as it will be displayed on the Team information board.

The Boxing Entries Check is mandatory for all Teams, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive timely for their respective appointment. Each Team may appoint a maximum of two people to attend its Boxing Entries Check (e.g. Team Leader and the Team Doctor). In order to be cleared for the competition, Teams must provide the following documents for each boxer, signed and completed as required:

- Copy of passport
- Record Book (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form (female boxers only), signed by the boxers legal guardian if boxer is a minor
- Uniforms (red and blue) per World Boxing Competition Rules

To complete the Boxing Entries process and receive accreditations, Teams must have fully settled their accommodation costs if this has been arranged with the LOC.

5. VISA & ENTRY TO THE HOST COUNTRY

Flemisch boxing federation will provide assistance to participating teams requiring Visas but cannot guarantee their acquisition. For information and visa support letters, please complete visa information form and email via roundrobin@vlaamseboksliga.com . The deadline to submit requests for visa support letters is 05 Sept 2026 (23:59 CET). It is the responsibility of participating Teams to ensure that their Teams respect the conditions of stay defined by the Government of the country hosting the event. If any participant does not respect these conditions, any costs arising will be borne by the respective National Federation.

6. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

The designated airport for arrival and departure of Teams is Brussels Zaventem International airport (BRU). Every Team will be picked up only once. If the team doesn't come together, the first members of the Team will have to wait for the rest of the delegation. All Teams must submit their arrival and departure details to the LOC via roundrobin@vlaamseboksliga.com by 16 September 2026 (23:59 CET). For additional information or in case of any issue, please email.

7. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

The LOC will provide airport transfers for all Teams and ground transport for R&J's and the teams. The Hopper Youth hostel is on walking distance (1,6km) from the Venue.

Additional transportation costs will apply when airport transfers or any other transportation is required outside of event days and costings will be sought on request

9.1 Payment terms

Teams are free to choose accommodation options most fitting for them. The accommodation proposed by the LOC is not mandatory. When teams choose to stay at Hopper Youth hostel they need to cover all expenses before checking in and make sure there are no open payments left after check out.

Please, request a corresponding invoice from the LOC before initiating the payment to settle the total amount.

10. IMAGE RIGHTS & VIDEO RECORDING

Flemish boxing league will film the event for broadcast, promotional videos and official event photographers will take still images of boxers before and during the event. All sessions will be open to the accredited media. By participating in the event, each Team Member agrees to release his/her image rights to the Flemish boxing league.

11. MEDICAL SERVICES & ANTI-DOPING

The Organizer will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

Doping control can be conducted in accordance with World Boxing Anti-Doping Rules and World AntiDoping Code. According to WADA regulations, blood testing may be conducted during this competition.

12. INSURANCE

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation and liability insurance covering the entire event and travel period.
